Every once in a while, an opportunity comes along you just can't pass up on. KBNF has been presented with one such an amazing opportunity. We have been offered 500-800 fully functional hospital beds with mattresses that will arrive between Sept. 15 and Nov. 15.

Yep. In three weeks.

We have multiple countries, hospitals and clinics that are anxiously awaiting those very beds. These beds would replace older models that are currently in use and give the hospitals a much-needed boost of support. Some smaller clinics will receive beds for the first time to allow for capacity-building and greater care.

We are hoping to send the complete package: bed, mattress and linens for each of these beds.



We cannot do this alone. To process and prep beds safely and securely for their trek across the ocean, we need to tie and secure all moving pieces. This requires additional space where we can work. We also need to receive the beds in one secure space, so we can ship directly from there.

We are looking for a partner who will come alongside us for a short-term five- to six-month period. Do you know someone who has vacant warehouse space, a store or parkade that would want to give back and support this initiative?

Here's what we need:

1. SPACE

A short-term space of 8,000-10,000 sq. ft. with a loading dock, ideally in the Surrey or Langley area from Sept. 15 until March 15.

2. VOLUNTEERS

- We need volunteers to help prepare beds and fold linens for the container loadings
- Strong volunteers to help lift beds on loading days.
- Financial support to help get containers to smaller clinics and facilities that cannot afford the cost of a container shipment.



We need a space and we need volunteers to process and ship 800 hospital beds.
